It is important that veterans receive care in all settings including community hospitals, academic centers, cancer hospitals, home care and hospices, since only 4% of veterans die in VA facilities. The Principal Investigator for the project has said "No other healthcare provider spends more time with these veterans and their family than the nurse,"

- Discuss aspects of assessing the psychological, spiritual, and social domains of veterans and families facing a life-threatening illness or event.
